Origins



- Global Compact in Spain was launched in 2002 by Rafael del Pino Foundation
- During the III General Assembly the Spanish GC Network became *Asociación Española del Pacto Mundial (ASEPAM)* being one of the first network worldwide to achieve legal status as a chartered organization

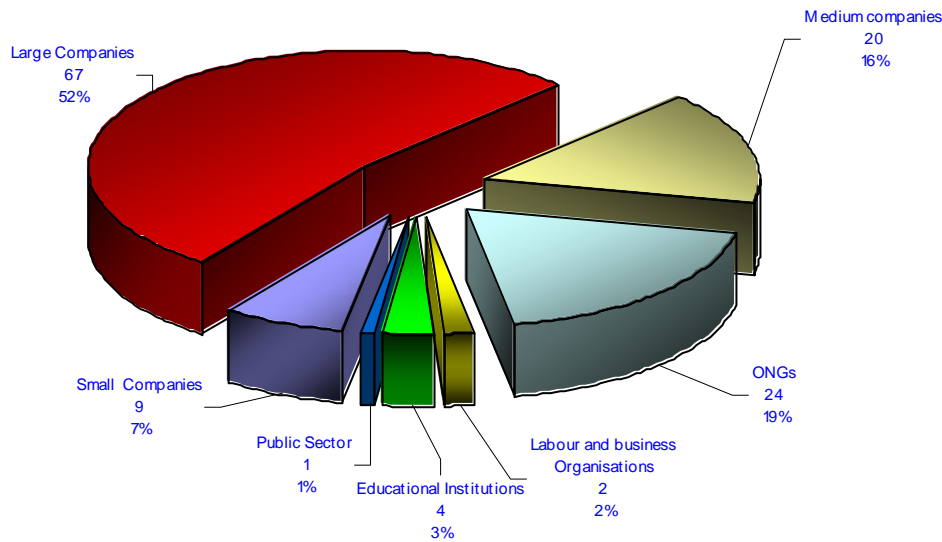

 - Non profit organizations (educational institutions, foundations, NGOs, etc...): 300 euros

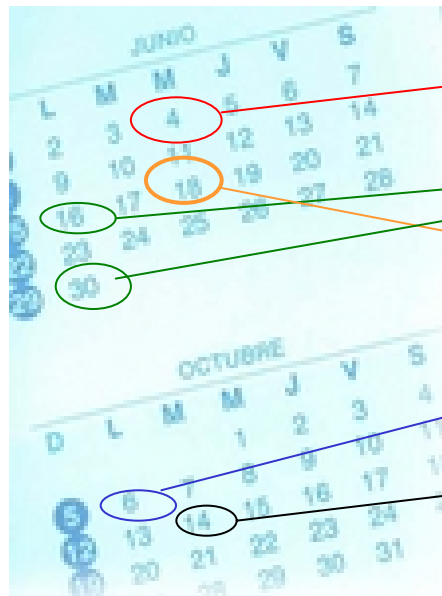
Sustainable Funding
