MULTI-STAKEHOLDER PROJECT ON ACCESS TO MEDICINES:

Access to medicines is radically linked to HHRR

Private companies should be INCORPORATED to the ENFORCEMENT OF THIS HHRR.

In the medium term:

Three complementary fields

1-EXPORT OF GENERICS (with due regard of WTO-TRIPS obligations & Doha Declaration on intellectual property & public health)

2-IMPROVEMENT OF KEY LOCAL PRODUCTION FACILITIES IN AFRICA

3-RACIONALIZING DISTRIBUTION

WE ARE PUSHING FOR THE ADHERENCE TO GC SPAIN OF SPECIFIC SPANISH PHARMACEUTICAL INDUSTRIES AS WELL AS COMPANIES SPECIALIZED ON LOGISTICS & NGOS SPECIALIZED ON HEALTH ASSISTANCE IN LDCs
