- Database that provides background information on business' involvement in **money laundering, fraud, involvement in terrorism and subject to govts/UN/financial regulatory agencies' sanctions**

Local Networks

- Before accepting new participants, their application is referred to the relevant Local Network for its perspective on whether there is any reason to deny the application.

Active: Use of GC Logos



- Regular and endorser logos require written permission from the GCO
- Regular logos
 - Only when the GCO is directly involved in the described activity
 - Highly contextualized situations e.g. box explaining the UNGC, list of initiatives.
- Endorser Logo
 - In all other cases
- Average 60-70 requests per month
- Online logo request system to streamline process (next month)

Active: Dialogue Facilitation

Systematic or egregious abuse of the UNGC principles



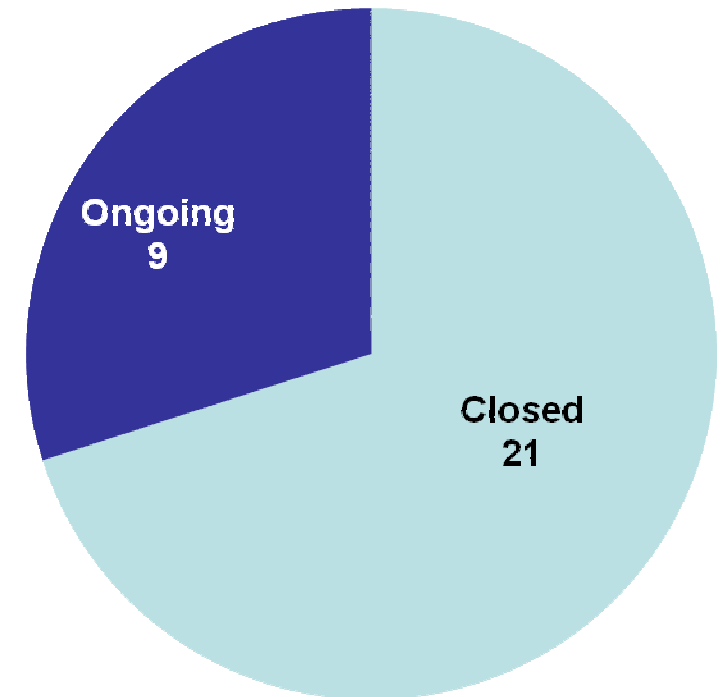
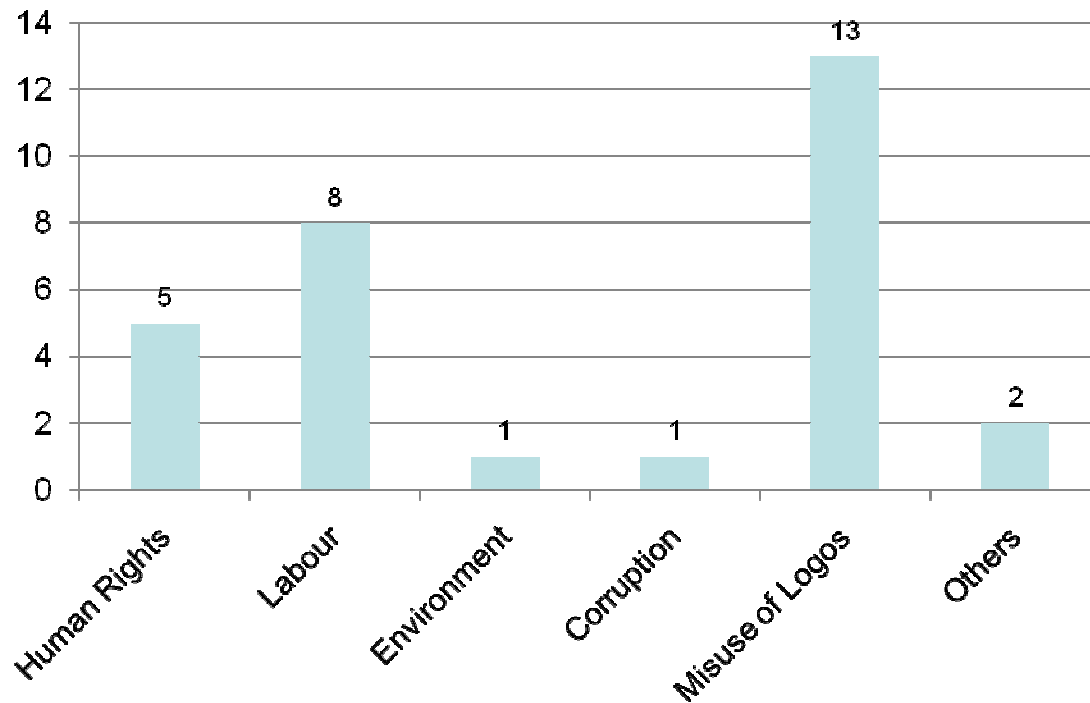
- Threshold assessment
- Consulting with others e.g. UN agencies, LNs

- Clarification of nature & purpose of IMs
- Ascertain willingness to forward the matter to the company

- Company is asked to respond directly to the person within three months

Suspension/removal by UN Procurement

Vendor Review Committee

- Review companies (Unethical Conduct or Poor Performance)
- Recommends to ASG to suspend or remove a company from the UN Procurement Vendor Roster

ASG of CSS

- Makes decision
- Informs the company

UN Procurement

- Suspends/removes the company from the UN Vendor Roster
- Provides the list to the GCO and copy of the letters sent

Global Compact Office

- For companies suspended/removed for ethical reasons, informs the company of its suspension/removal from the UNGC



Reinstatement of suspended companies

- Provide evidence on remedial actions for VRC's review
- Code of conduct, policy statement, pardon from their own government, etc.
