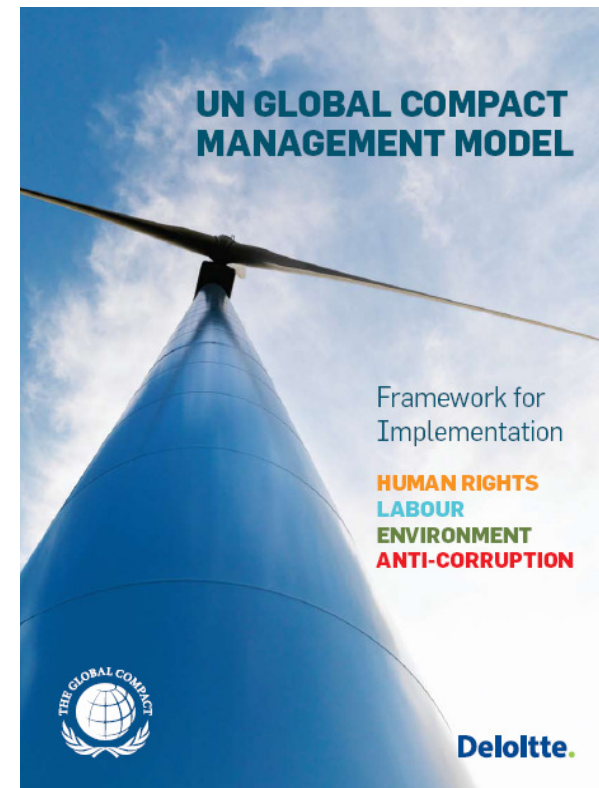

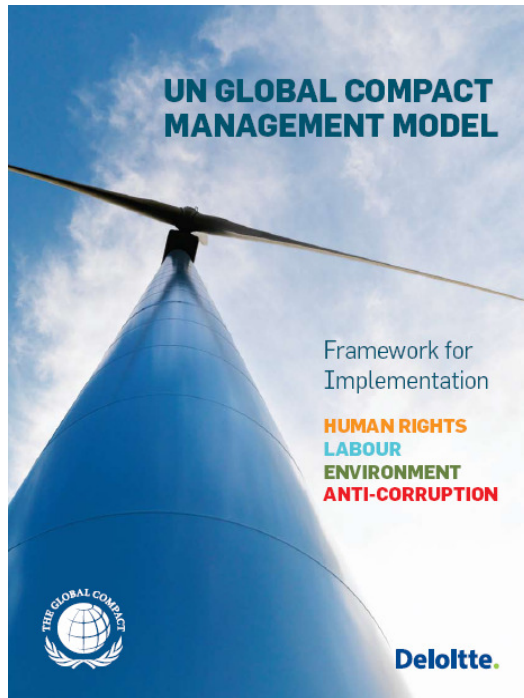
Application of the Management Model
