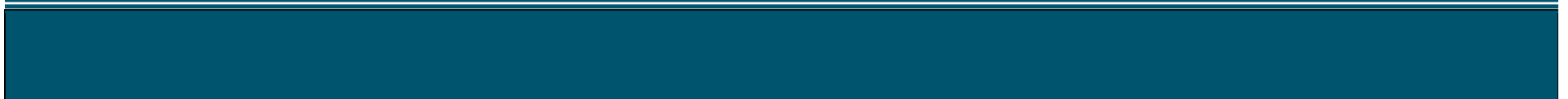




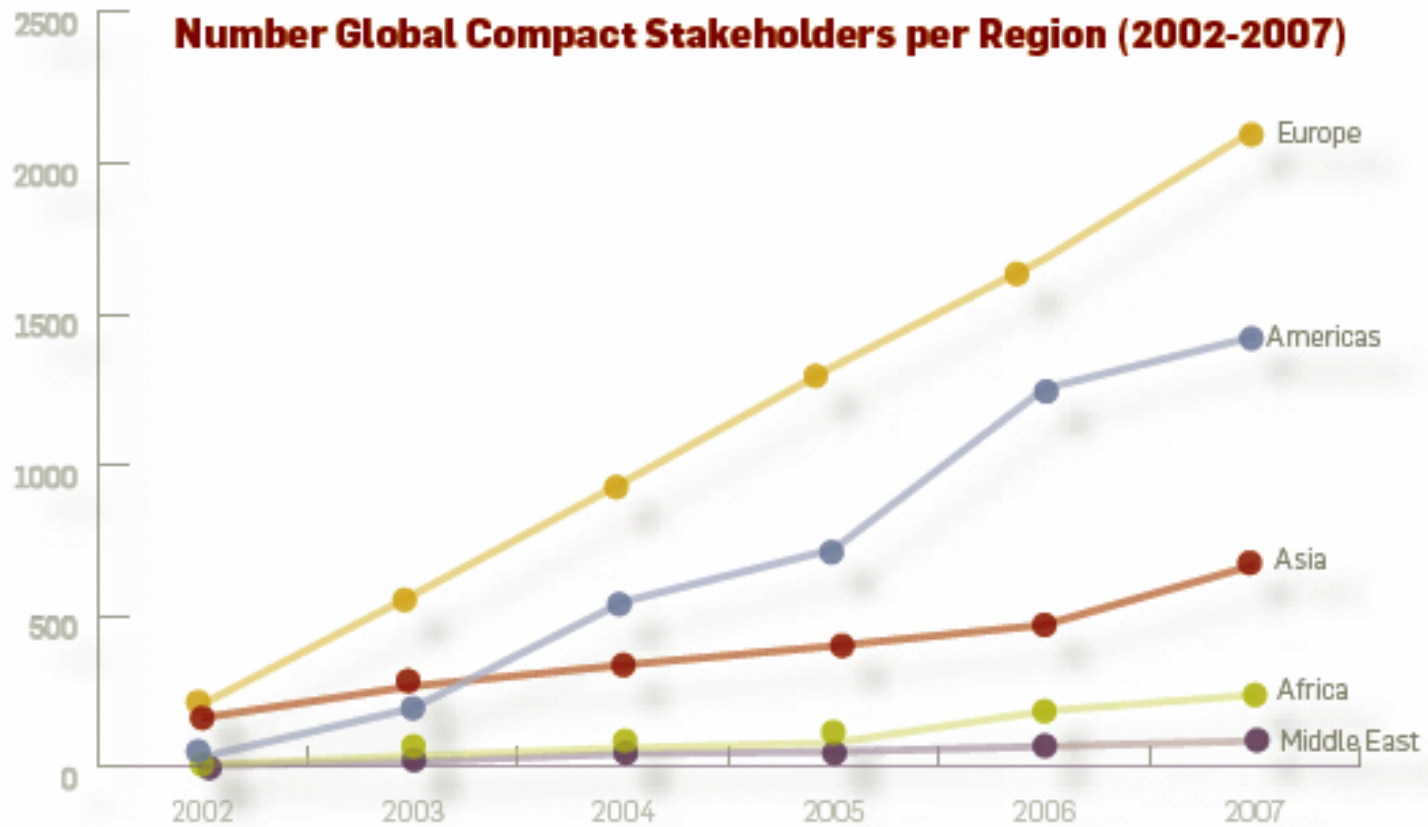

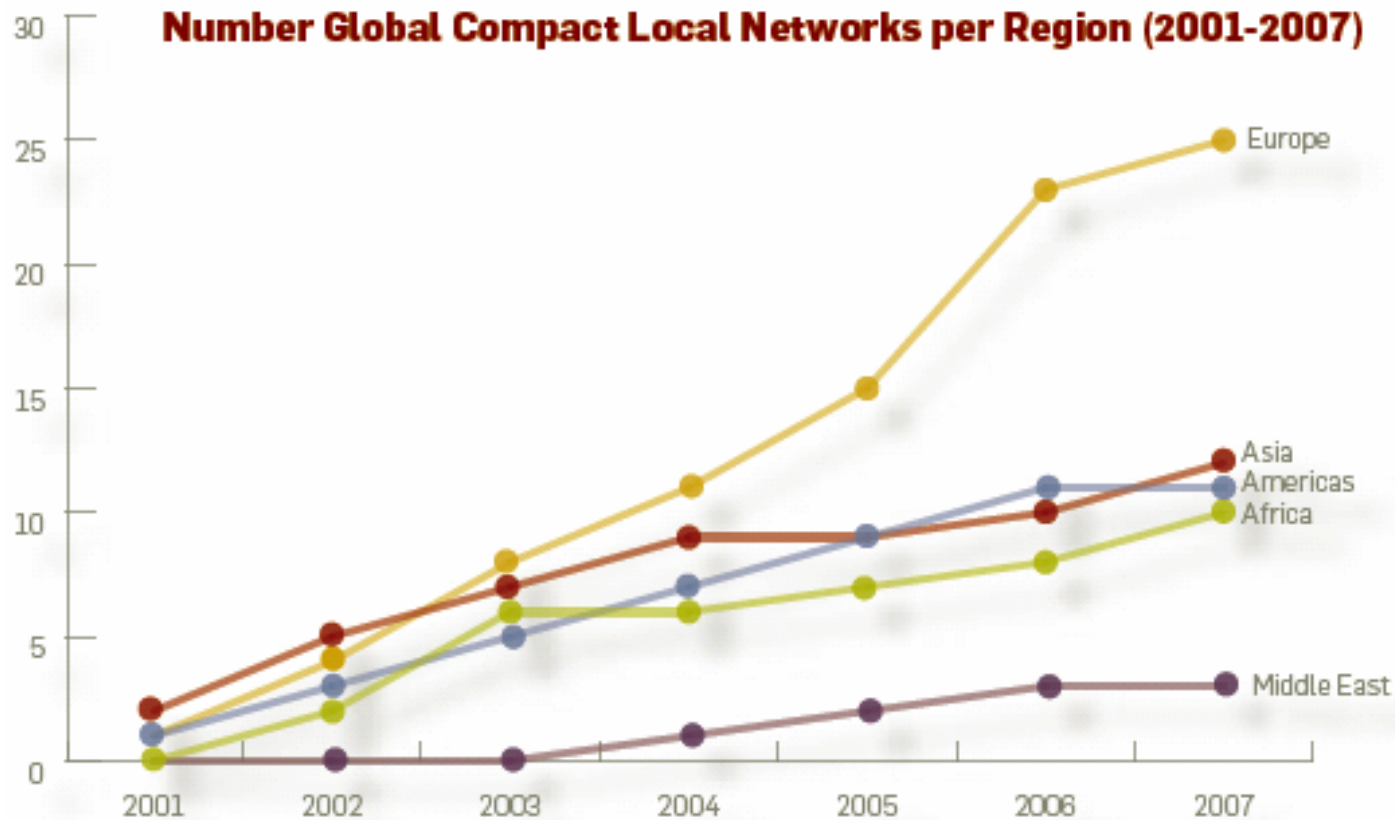


Steady growth - Participants



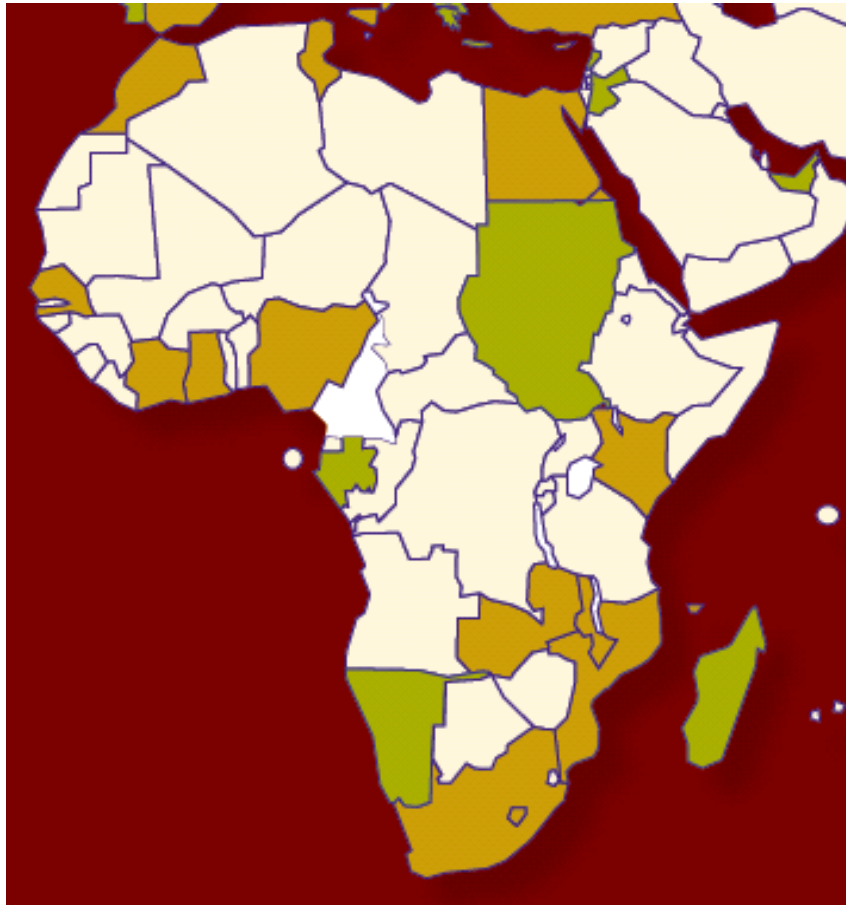

Steady growth - GCLNs



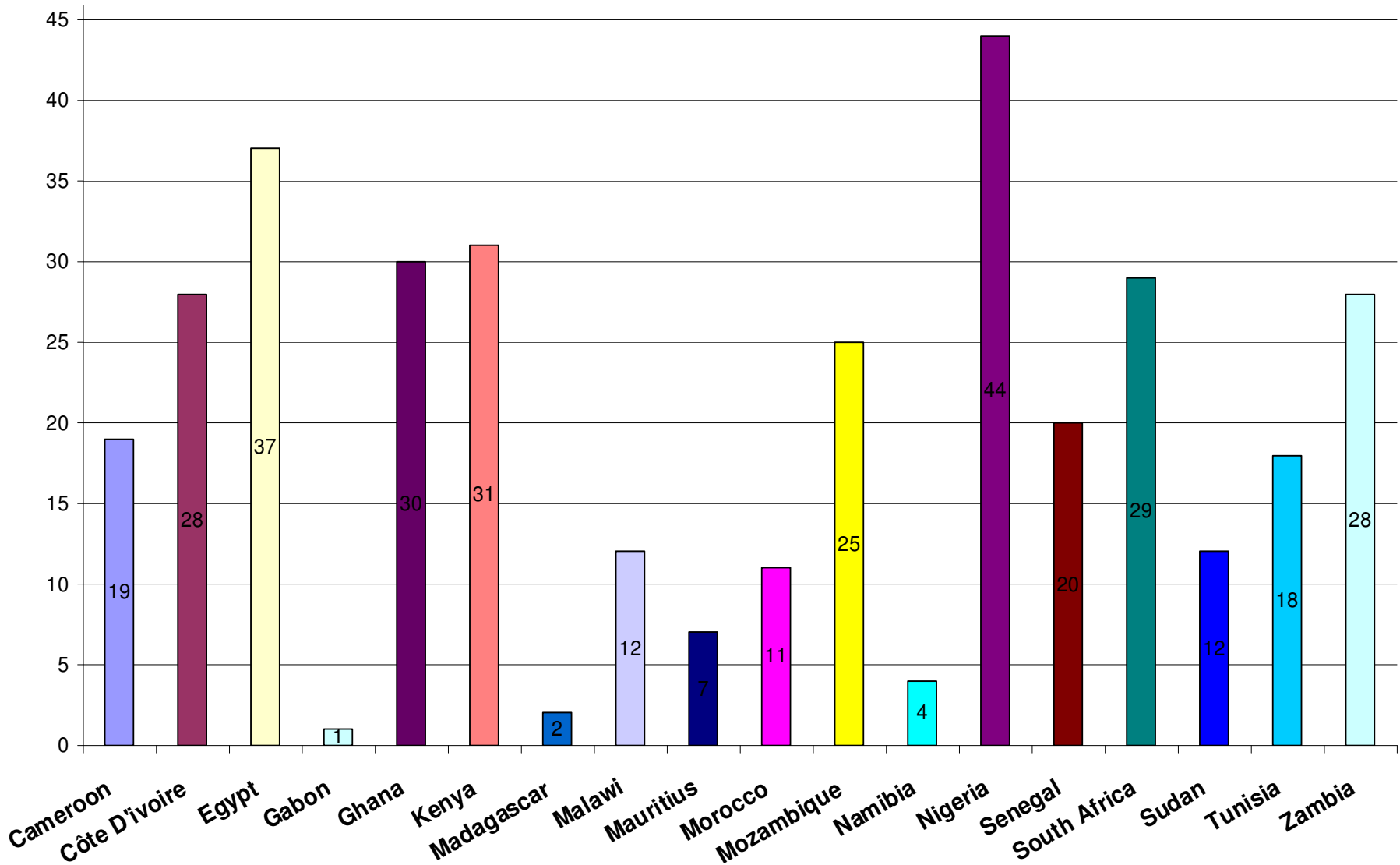

GCLNs in Africa



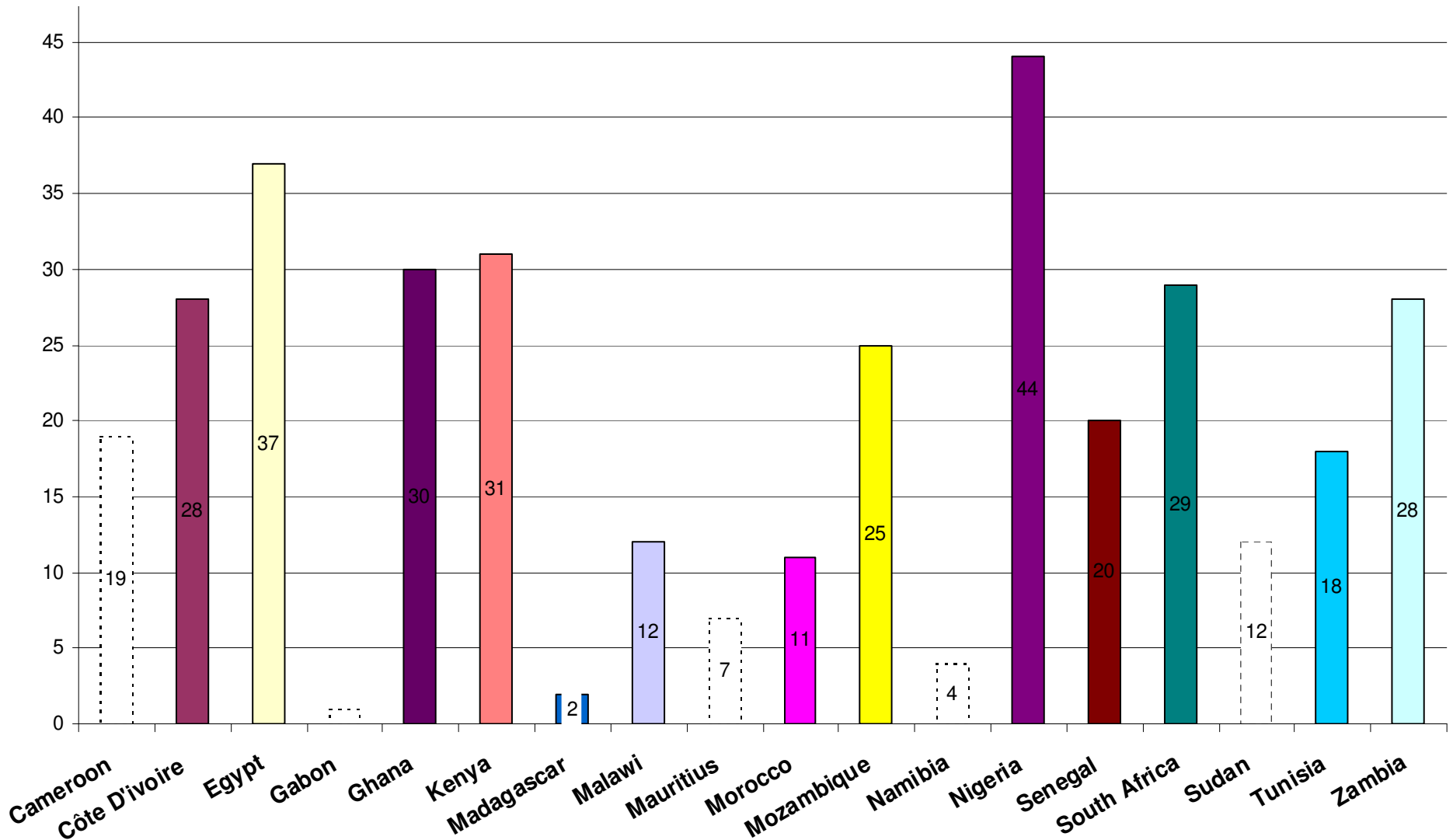

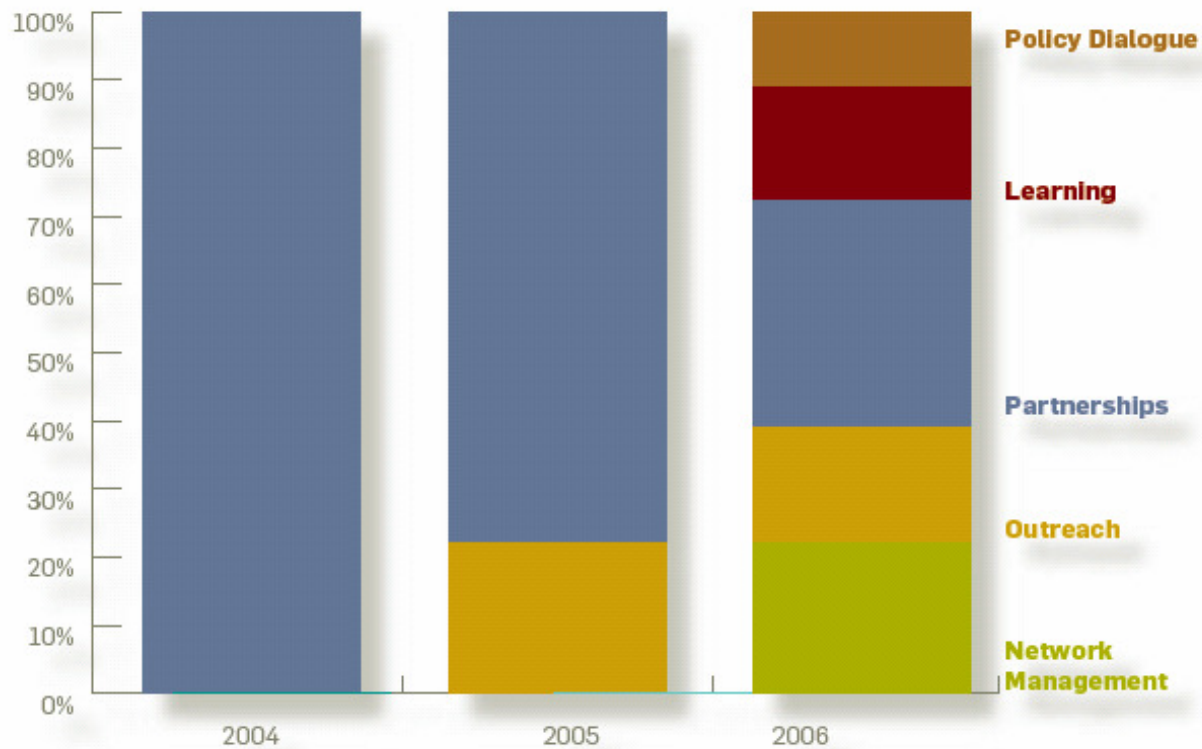

Reported Local Network Activities in Africa 2004-2006 (% per year)



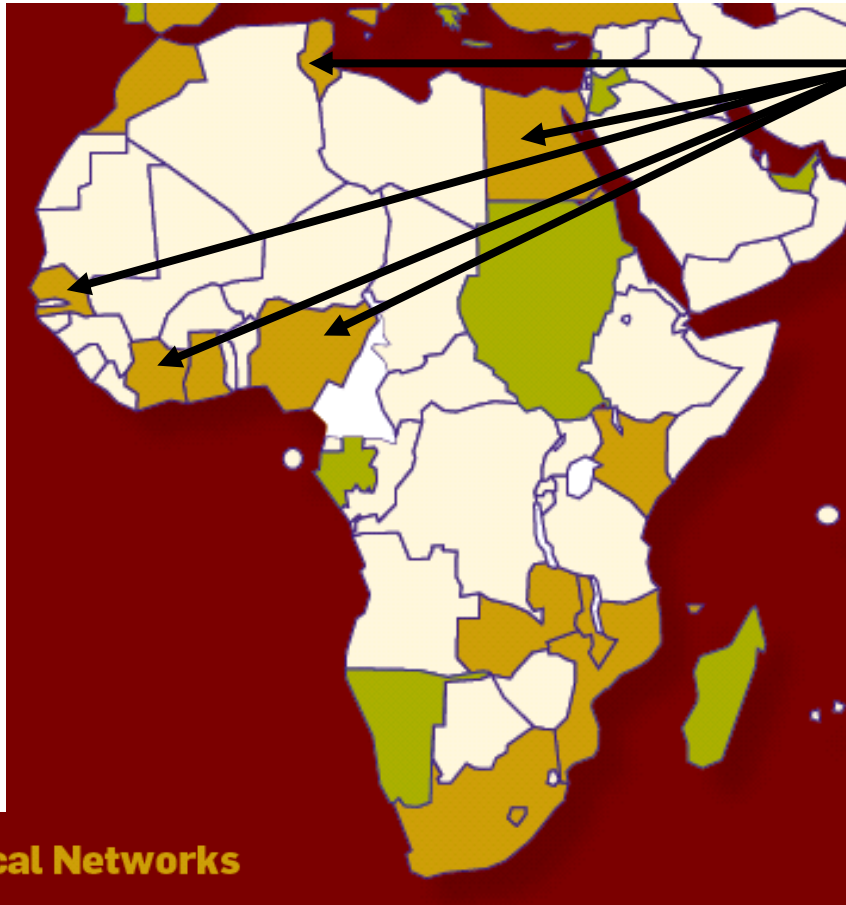
