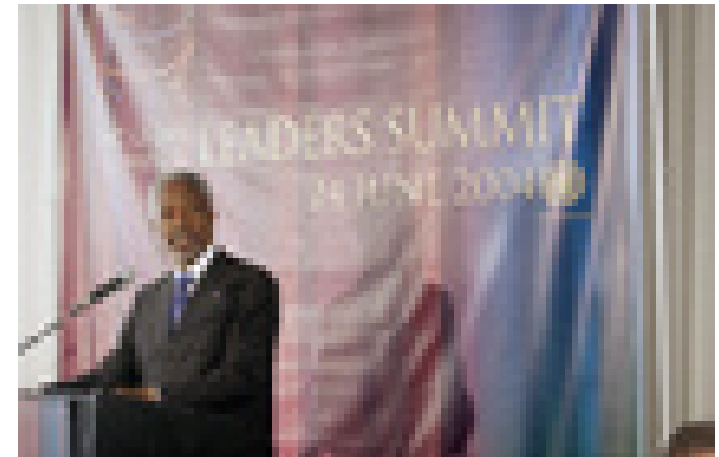

 - DSM
 - Accelerated DSM programme
 - Solar water heating
 - Billion kWh internal drive



Eskom's experience with the Global Compact

- Diversification of energy mix
 - 100 MW wind facility
 - Gas
 - Clean coal
 - Nuclear
- Suppliers
 - New build has afforded the opportunity to communicate the Global Compact principles with suppliers
 - Development of contractor safety forums where the principles of human rights and labour standards are operationalised



Eskom's experience with the Global Compact

- Business conduct policies
 - Ethics pledge
 - Compulsory Ethics workshops for all employees to attend.
 - Eskom Code of conduct for suppliers ensures that suppliers know the principles under which Eskom operates and adopts “best practice.”

 - Gender
 - Disability
