Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that *Breathing Games* supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.

The *Breathing Games* mission is to foster breathing health by developing an open source standard for games related to breathing. It aims to generate:

- a community to build and share the commons – resources accessible to everyone
- a process to help stakeholders from different organizations build on collective intelligence
- a software development kit with examples and specifications to create science-based games
- blockchain data management that preserves users' privacy and fosters scientific research
- a marketplace with processes to call contributors, validate outcomes, redistribute the raised funds

With this commitment, we express our intent to support the *Global Compact* advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.


We also pledge to participate in and engage with the *UN Global Compact* in the following ways:
